Documentation will be shared on the Northern-Southern website and social media. Maps to the sites will be available upon request.


At the conclusion of the month, the maps will be collected in a print 'zine, in which each artist will be interviewed.



At the entrance to the South Walnut Creek trail, off of Jain Lane, you will find a tree.



# Suzanne Wyss *100 Hugs* May 21, 2020



The hugs are free for the taking for a week.


#### Wyss writes:
